CEF Financial Bursary

A single parent has two children attending one of our secondary schools and has two older, fully dependent children

living at home due to their disabilities.

The parent is a sole carer due to domestic violence.

The parent's business was affected by COVID-19 lockdowns and with income at an all-time low—the only source of income was Job Keeper payment—their bills, inclusive of school fees, became extremely overdue. Their ability to pay for living expenses and debts at the same time diminished.

Embarrassed by the situation, the parent refused to answer or return school calls. However, due to the school's caring pastoral approach and gentle persistence from the school's business manager, the parent felt comfortable accepting an Application for Financial Assistance.

Unfortunately, at this time, the parent did not complete the application and the account was transferred to the School Fee Support Unit (SFSU) to manage. Several calls from the SFSU were unanswered until they left an empathetic message:

"We care and want to help you... but we need you to respond."

The parent then returned the call and divulged that they were depressed, embarrassed and extremely stressed at having to move back into the grandparents' small home to get on top of their debts. They advised that "the children's education was important" and did not want to move them to another school as their current school's 'faith and community' was paramount to them. With this trust in the SFSU, they provided full documentation, and the children were awarded a financial bursary. The school also assisted in providing uniform vouchers for the children. The parent was so overwhelmed and sent a message of thanks:

"Thank you so much for what you did to help me and my kids. I appreciate everything you have done"
