### **Aboriginal Torres Strait Islander Bursary Story**

One of our Primary schools had tried working with an Aboriginal family to complete an application form for an Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander bursary.

This was over a few years and during this time the fees were not being paid and the debt was accruing.

The school spoke with the Student Wellbeing Aboriginal & Torres Strait Islander team and asked if they could approach the family. After meeting mum, they became aware she was illiterate and had been unable to complete the form and felt embarrassed to tell the school.

This team helped her complete the form and the bursary was awarded and the outstanding debt was addressed. Mum now pays \$260 a year for her child to continue to receive a Catholic Education in the community she is nurtured and cared for
